Play this very fast, muting at first and gradually letting go

of the string

Scratch the 4th and 5th strings to make the Seagull effect. (use the delay! - play the chord and mute it almost immediately)

the strings for the seagull effect again. Then play the normal

verse figure

and the chorus, and after the chorus comes the finale:

Play this a couple of times
