Sorry Cassandra I (**G7**) didn't believe

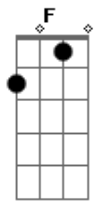
You really had the (**C**) power

Knowing, though you're late, that ship is sure to wait

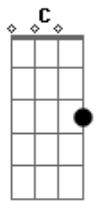

I'm sorry Cassandra

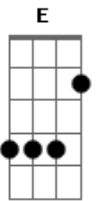
