Then it's just **A** (8 down-strokes) **B** (8 down-strokes) and by the end of the first verse, this:

A **B**

Back to the main lick, during the chorus, just play every part twice. Then play the during the second verse:

A **B** **A** **B**

After that there's a little break, it goes like this:

Play it twice, but change the last section of the solo for this:

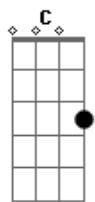
Then there's the chorus with a slight variation in the end:

Right after that, whoa KEY CHANGE (don't be alarmed, it's the same formula):

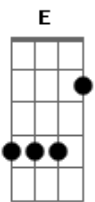
Play this lick until the song ends then this:
