His courtship had just begun

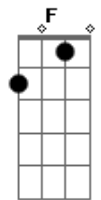
Said young man, "Have you hauled some corn?"

Little miss what do you say?"

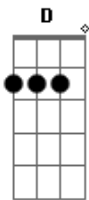
"Why do you come for me to wed?

Givin me the devil cause I wouldn't hoe corn."

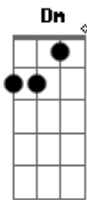

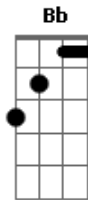

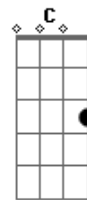
