

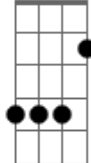
Beck - Where Its At

Just so you don't think I'm an idiot. ~ means hammer on means pull off Listen to the song to figure out when each of these parts is played and when. The main riff is as follows. This is part A.

E----5-----|---5-----|
They play this 4 times before going into the "Where it's at" part which is just an E played at different times. you should be able to figure it out if you're not stupid. That is part B. The third part is kinda like a bridge. This is part C. It's played twice at a time.
D-----5-----3----|-----2--2-----0---2-|
A-----3---5-----|-----2-----|
E---3-----|---0-----|
