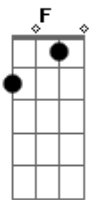

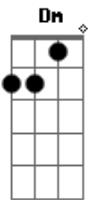

 You don't know what love is.

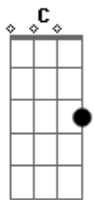
