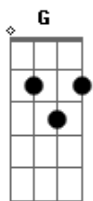

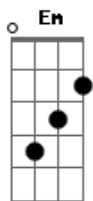

Strangers can be lovers again

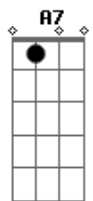
