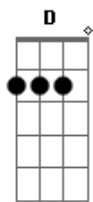

The next bit is the best part of the song. It starts all heavy and anxious and then it finishes all relaxed and cool, enjoy.

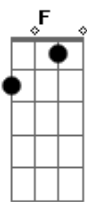
