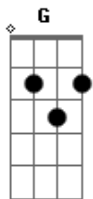
Down in some lone valley ^{Am}

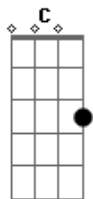
Who owns a house and land

 Wherever I go ^D

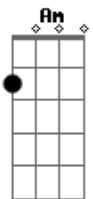

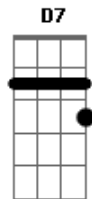

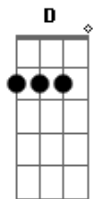
