(Db Bbm Db Bbm Db Bbm)

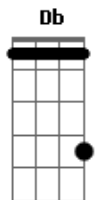

Guess I must have lost the keys

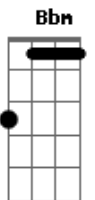
