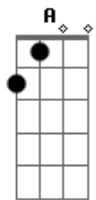
There is also another part I notice no one ever tabs. During the second verse there is a quiet harmonic guitar arpeggiating in the background.

If you want to throw in a neat solo or something just for fun, I suggest **Abm** pentatonic with some blues notes. Here it is for those of you who don't know it.

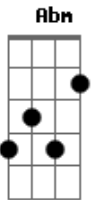
