On a cold winters night that was so deep

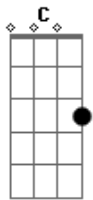
C Em F C G

and night.

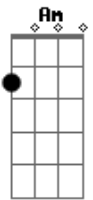
This star drew nigh to the North West, O'er Bethlehem it took

frankincense.

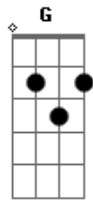
