If you love me, won't you let me know?

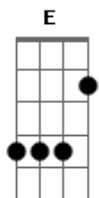
Was a long and dark December

Hollowed out to fit their rifles

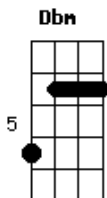
And the cross was held aloft
