There's a mismatch of carriages, soil in a boat for some flowers

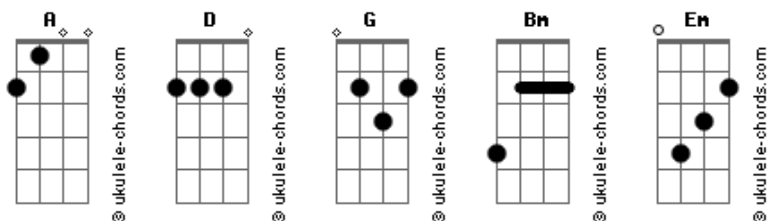
