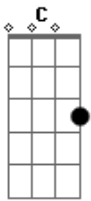

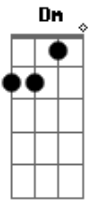
1. I can't light no more of your darkness,

Bb-F-G#-Bb-C REFRAIN

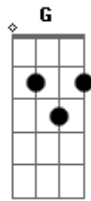
