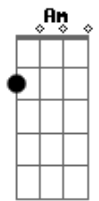

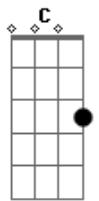

 You have everything I need

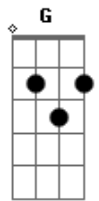

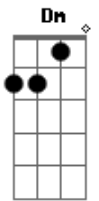

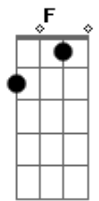
