^C If you put him off it's a shame

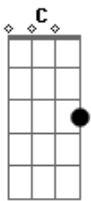
Taking his hand a collection she made

^{D7} The boy's words would ring in his ear ^{G7} ^C

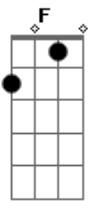
Please Mr. Conductor

^{D7} Before God takes her away ^{G7} ^C

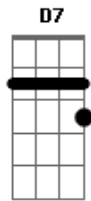

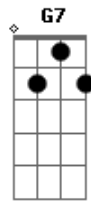
