And the men all wished to be me, they burned in all their jealousy

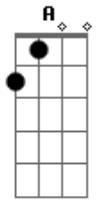

My fence was tall, to keep out the people that were wanting more

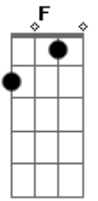

He ran and kissed me

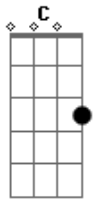

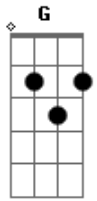

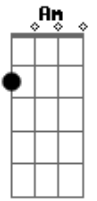
