The meadow lark singing to you each and every day

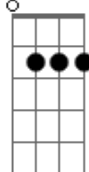
The arclad on the hills and the market in the hay

The song ends on a **G** major chord.

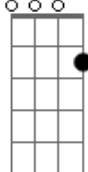
