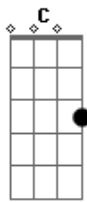

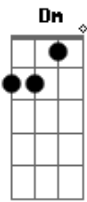

That's why the lady is a tramp

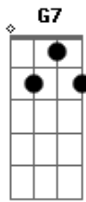
