

George Harrison - Here Comes The Sun

Tom: **D** D chord **G** chord **E7** chord

(com acordes na forma de **G**)
 Capotraste na 7ª casa
 The song is played capoed at the 7th fret.

I've just included the parts. Some assembly required.

George is just strum/picking (somewhere in between, that is) the chords while playing the melody as the top note of the chord. For example (I won't try to exactly match the strumming, just list the basic notes. The basic chord is played up to the melody note on pretty much all of these) the intro/verse part is:

D chord **G** chord **A7** chord

 and into the lick:


then:

The end is just the "sun, sun, here it comes" lick. submitted by nick






