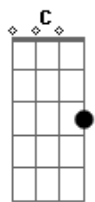

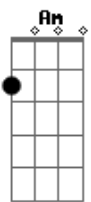
We skipped the light Fandango

 Turned a whiter shade of pale

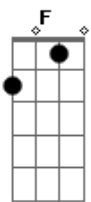
