Note that while the repeating pattern is playing only use an MAIN RIFF: Gb power chord, do not play it as a major or minor chord. Listen for the strumming and muting of the B power chord. The repeating pattern can be varied during the Bm section A (E) D Db A by alternatively hammering on to the 12th fret instead of the $\,$ В 11th. I've written it bar by bar to show the syncopation. (E) For the next two parts I'll just show the basic idea: Listen for the muting.
