BRIDGE:

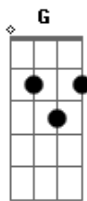

Such an honest girl

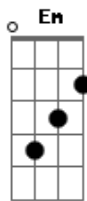

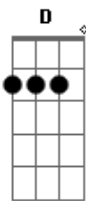

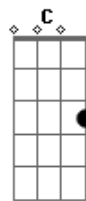
