

Jane Monheit - I Get Along Without You Very Well

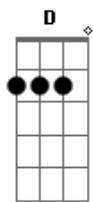

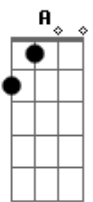
D Bm G A7 D Cdim G G D

For that would surely break my heart in two

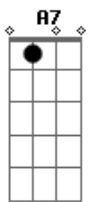
