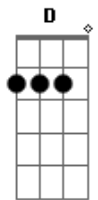

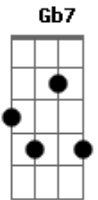

The folks who live on the hill

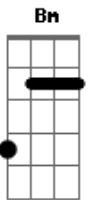
