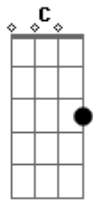
There's cowboys that still sit with their backs to the wall **C**

D7 Elvis Presley James Dean ole rocking Jerry Lee **G**

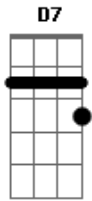

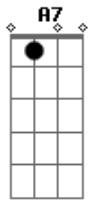

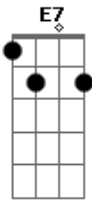
