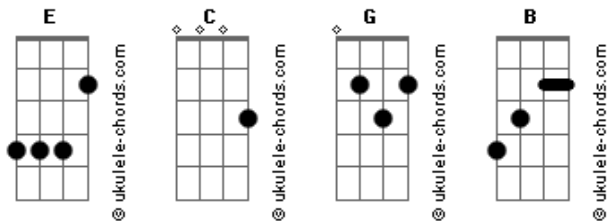
I did some looking and found that J0**C** uses an open **E** modal tuning on most
