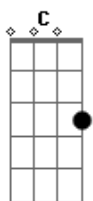

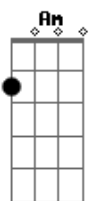

C G

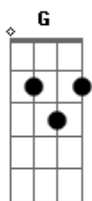

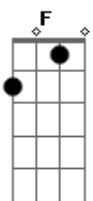
