Then: -/ indicates upward slide Basic riff: Kev: ~ Sustain the note Bend - e.g '12 14' means bend from 12 up to 14, '14 12' is to release the note back to the 12th then: "Don't want to be a thorn in your side..." \ Downward slide Upward slide X Palm mute This is the instrumental part with the lil licks Harmonic Ghost note.. u don't have to play it Its kinda rusty on the structure side but it's a start..
