I thought that I could get by **A** by myself.

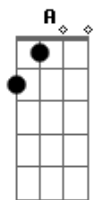

I need to feel the touch of Your tender hand.

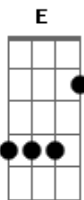
Remove the chains of darkness

I'm beggin' You, please, Help Me.

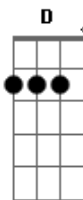
