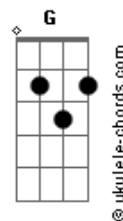
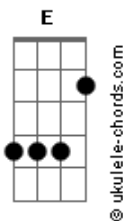
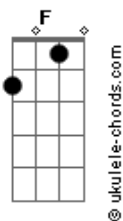
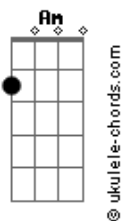
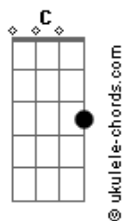
Am F C
