F G I am sure, I'm holding fast C

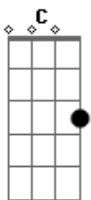
I am dying for a lifetime that will last.

Solo: (as sure as dogs can fly)

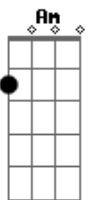
