C Will endure, and carry on ? into The Comming Dawn.

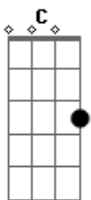
C The breezes blow, soft clouds drift by Am

I am dying for a lifetime that will last.

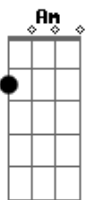
F But when my world starts to fade Dm

F Will endure, and carry on ? into The Comming Dawn. Dm

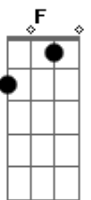

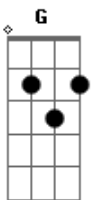

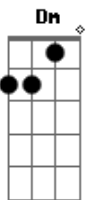
