Obviously, after listening to the "COHEN LIVE!" performance,
the capo
should be on the 9th fret and the song starts in G, instead of
C capo 4,
or even E (no capo) as I've often seen.

Basically, the notes are exactly the same as in the previous
version,
but it's much EASIER to play it that way (that's what L.
Cohen does
anyway), and it sounds just beautiful.

(in the "COHEN LIVE!" performance, the capo is on the the 3rd
fret,
i.e. 3 tones lower than the studio version)
