And see what a year will bring.

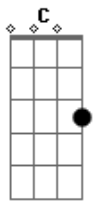

He's so ambitious, he even sews.

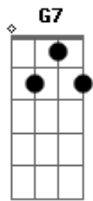

For makin' whoopee.

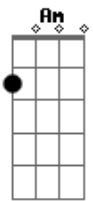
