p indicates pull off, and

h indicates hammer on

q indicates quarter tone bend. Intro: and Verse - Clean guitar with Chorus and Delay Eb F

It goes Eb - F - Eb - F - Eb - F - F - F.

SR arpeggiates the chords second time around.

After the second 'chorus' he whips on a capo at the third fret and plays an arpeggiated ${\sf Cm}$ as follows.
