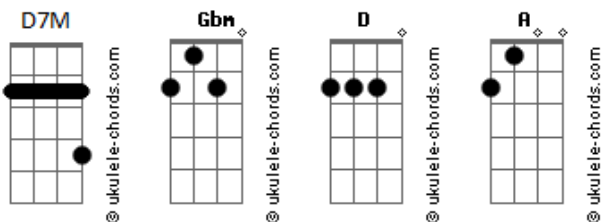


Movements - Colorblind (Acoustic)
