Feels like more than I can take F Gm

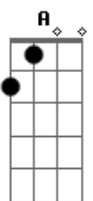

More than I can hold

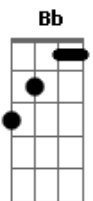
[Terceira Parte]

Wrap its arms around me

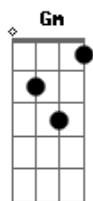

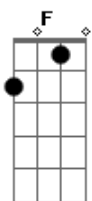

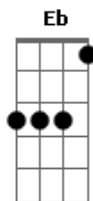
