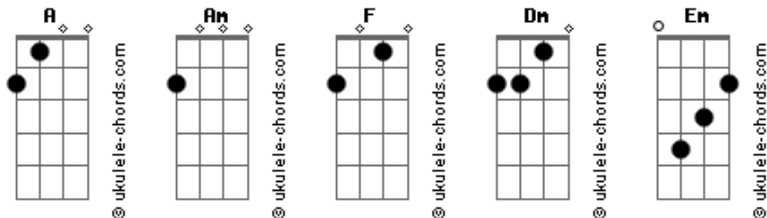
Am
