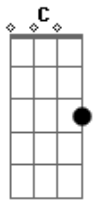

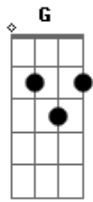
C G Am C

each be lonely. Was it just the season.

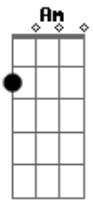

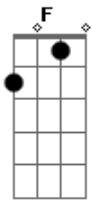

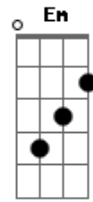
