 (**D**) So I can feel at ease and go (**A**) back to my (**D**) home

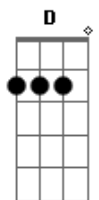

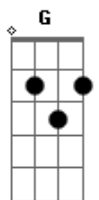

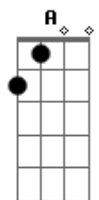
