 Where streams run clear and Lord the skies they are so blue **E A A**

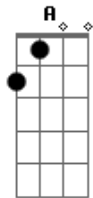

Then the spoken verse about the road trip weekend.

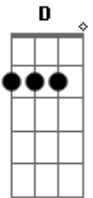
It's a two day old burrito on a lukewarm beer to go **A D**

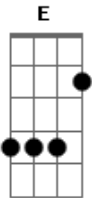

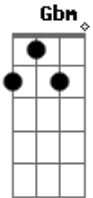
