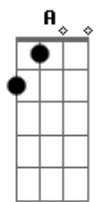

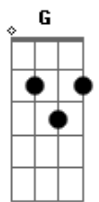

 I THINK I'VE GOT NO HOME

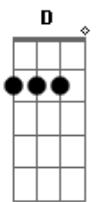
