and she locked him into the bedroom. Oh, oh, oh.

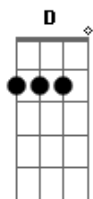
Now I am alone, said she,

is really nothing but a handful of skin.

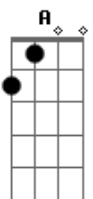
Stroll on, baby, step right in?.

Well, let the party, the party begin.

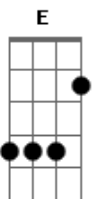
