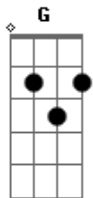


Peter Paul And Mary - I Dig Rock And Roll Music

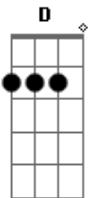
tom:

 (D Em7 D Em7)

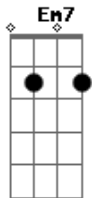
