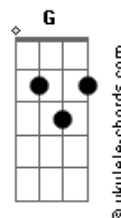
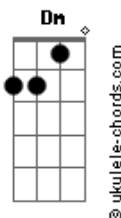
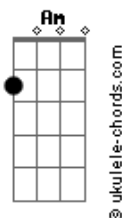
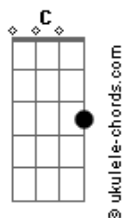
There's no place in this world where I'll belong when I'm gone C Am
