Intro: The shimmering "Don Henley - Boys Of Summer" thing in the background is something along these lines :

Verse and intro

Your basic 2-chord progression. Strum to the rhythm. Play them open for the Intro: , and then roll it back to single palm-muted notes for the verses.

A Db A Db -

Pre-Chorus

Open power chords.

B Db B Db B Db A B

Then this tasty little lick to transition into the chorus.

Chorus:

Simple power chords will suffice. I'll synch this up with the lyrics to give you a better feel for the rhythm.
