

Ray Charles - Busted

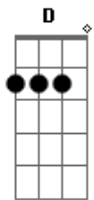
Tom: **D**

i'm broke ,no bread,i mean like nothing

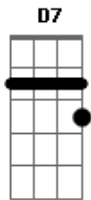
