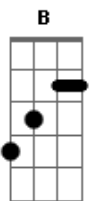


Samantha Ebert - No One Knows

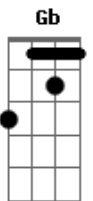

A chapter of life tucked away on a shelf

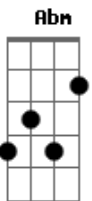

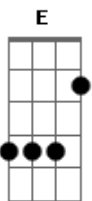

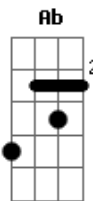
